


## How do I allow clubs in my hierarchy to play in more than one associations competitions?

You may have clubs within your hierarchy that want to play in the competitions setup by other associations or leagues.

To allow this to happen, you need to give them permission.

Hover over My Organisation and select My Hierarchy.



Click the Permissions tab.



Tick the box in front of the name(s) of the club(s) to which you want to give permission. Click **Mass Update Selected Rows**.
